Continuing Education

Stormwater Inspections

At least 10 stormwater site inspections must be completed for re-registration. Qualifying site inspections must be performed on a site that is required to have a UPDES permit according to the Utah Administrative Code (see R317-8-2 and R317-8-3)*. The inspection must be intended to inspect for permit requirements. If an inspection is performed by more than one inspector, the inspection may qualify as a site inspection for all inspectors participating in the inspection.

* Inspections on sites where a UPDES permit is not required may qualify subject to RSI committee review. The Inspection forms for non-UDPES sites must be substantially equivalent to the State UPDES inspection form. Copies of inspection reports for these inspections must be submitted with re-application form.
